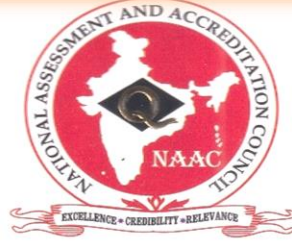

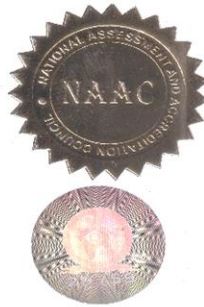

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Admission to T.D.C. 1st Semester class is open for those who have passed H.S. (10+2) standard examinations conducted by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council or Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) or any other equivalent examinations.

The application will have to be submitted along with attested photocopy of marksheet and certificates at the time of application. They will have to produce the original copies of the certificate and marksheet at the time of admission.

COLLEGE UNIFORM

Boys: White Shirt and Black Trousers.

Girls: i) Muga or Muga Coloured Mekhela. White blouse and Chadar with Blue border or

ii) White Salwar Kamieez and Blue Surni.

iii) It is compulsory for the girls to wear mekhela-chadar on every Monday & Thursday.

N.B.: Every Student will have to wear Black Shoes. In winter Season they will have to wear Navy-blue Sweater or coat.

Student without Uniform will not be allowed to attend classes.

Leggings are not allowed.

ATTENDANCE

- i) To be eligible to appear in each semester final examination, a student must attend minimum classes in each individual subject as under- Minimum 75% and above: Eligible for the Examination.
- ii) Scholarship holders with less than 75% attendance may be deprived of the scholarship.

Students Union

Nonoi college student's union is the general body of students of the college and all the students are the member of the union. The election of Nonoi College student's union is held as per guidelines of Lyngdoh committee and The Honourable Supreme Court of India. Dated 22-09-2006. The guidelines are follows –

- 1) Under Graduate students between the ages of 17 and 22, Only can contest the election.
- 2) The candidates should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
- 3) The candidate should have the minimum percentage of attendance in classes as prescribed by the university of 75% attendance, whichever is higher.
- 4) The candidates shall not have previous criminal record. The candidates shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the college authority.
- 5) The candidate must be a regular full-time student of the college.



IDENTITY CARD

Identity Cards will be issued to Students of TDC, First, Third & Fifth Semester Classes. The students of other Classes will have to renew the identity Cards every Six Months after admission. The students must keep the Identity Cards with them during College hours and produce them on demand by the Principal or any Assistant Professors of the College. They will have to surrender their identity Cards at the time of issue of Marksheet/Certificate of the final examination.

COLLEGE EXAMINATION

There will be one sessional exam and one end semester exam in each semester, Sessional exam will be conducted by college and end semester exam will be conducted by G.U. TDC Semester System: 20% of total marks comes from internal assessment/evaluation and rest from end Semester evaluation. There Shall be at least one Sessional examination in each Semester. Pass Mark is 40%, If anybody fails in internal assessment then he will be declared fail even he/she scores pass mark in the last semester evaluation.

ONLINE FORM FILL UP FOR ADMISSION

Nonoi College has made all admission online from the Session 2020-21, in Keeping with the Govt. order, Applicants have to visit the website www.nonoicollege.in and Click at the 'Online Admission' button. There will be elaborate instructions about how to register, pay fees and Submit admission form in the website and students have to follow them accordingly.

FOUR-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (FYUGP) UNDER GAUHATI

Nonoi College proudly offers the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) under Gauhati University, aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020. This innovative programme provides flexibility and academic excellence through multiple entry and exit points. Students can earn a Certificate after one year, a Diploma after two years, a Bachelor's degree after three years, and a Bachelor's degree with Honours or Honours with Research after four years.

The FYUGP follows an interdisciplinary approach, encouraging students to explore various subjects beyond their core discipline.

Emphasizing skill development and practical learning, the programme integrates research projects, internships, and skill enhancement courses to prepare students for diverse career paths. It offers specialization opportunities in Arts and Science streams, fostering critical thinking, creativity, and lifelong learning.

At Nonoi College, the FYUGP equips students with holistic education, blending academic depth with flexibility to meet the evolving demands of higher education and employment.

Change of combination of subjects: There shall not be any change of combination of subjects after the regulated time. The principal in consultation with HOD of concerned subject may allow change of the subjects within seven days of the commencement of the class.





GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE AND ACADEMIC ATMOSPHERE AMONG STUDENTS

- i) The students will have to abide by college rules and regulations.
- ii) Violation of College rules and regulation may lead to suspension or expulsion from the college.
- iii) Possession and consumption of any intoxicating substance inside the College campus is strictly prohibited.
- iv) All powers of maintenance of discipline and good academic atmosphere are vested in the principal and his decision shall be final in such matters.
- v) A student is entrusted with the responsibility of producing his/her correspondence book to his/her parents/ guardians and return it to the authority in time.
- vi) Guardians should ensure their wards' regularly in participating in curricular and co-curricular activities of the college.
- vii) A student must obtain permission from the principal (from a Lecture under special circumstances) to leave the college campus during college hours.
- viii) A student is not allowed to enter the college campus, class room & examination hall with Mobile Phone.
- ix) Students are not allowed to meet friends in the college campus during college hours.
- x) Students without Uniform will not allow to attend classes and in examination hall.
- xi) The course of absence must be informed to obtain permission from the principal to attend classes after remaining absent for more than 3 days at stretch.
- xii) The students will have to maintain high standard of discipline, good conduct and abide by rules and regulations of the college prescribed by the college authority. - xiii) Ragging is strictly prohibited.

- ii. **Canteen:** The College Canteen provides traditional food, fast food and light refreshments to students and college staff under hygienic conditions at affordable price.
- iii. **Scholarship**
UGC Scholarship: A) For general category-APL/BPL certificate has to be produced.
B) For OBC/MOBC (non creamy layer)/ SC/ST category.
Minority Scholarship: (A) Annual income certificate from the DDO's for the students whose father/mother is in service.
(B) Annual income certificate from the Circle officer/Mouzadar for the students whose father/ mother is not in service.
General Scholarship: Students may claim National Scholarship, State Merit Scholarship, ST/SC/OBC/ Minority Scholarship according to their choice and eligibility subject to Govt. rule 3 of 7. Provision is there for cash awarded for students who are differently able.



Ishan Uday: The Ishan Uday Scheme sponsored by the UGC (University Grants Commission) has been availing by our first-year undergraduate students from the academic year 2015-16, The students whose family income should not exceed Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Nonoi College is delighted to announce its enthusiastic adoption of the Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) commencing from the academic session of 2023-24. It will be implementing in alignment with the guidelines laid out by Gauhati University, UGC, and the government's directives regarding the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

This new initiative reflects our commitment to providing students with a comprehensive and immersive learning experience, promoting interdisciplinary studies, skill development, and research-oriented education. By embracing the FYUGP, Nonoi College aims to empower students to become well-rounded individuals equipped with the knowledge, skills, and competencies necessary for their future endeavors.

The key features of GU-FYUGP (Four Year Under Graduate Programme) are as follows:

Duration: GU-FYUGP is a four-year honours or research programme. However, students also have the option to pursue a three-year degree programme with a major or without a major.

Programmes offered: GU-FYUGP offers various undergraduate programmes, including Bachelor of Arts (BA). These programmes provide comprehensive education in their respective disciplines.

Research focus: The programme emphasizes research-oriented learning, allowing students to develop critical thinking, analytical skills, and in-depth knowledge in their chosen fields of study.



Under the GU-FYUGP (Gauhati University - Four Year Under Graduate Programme) at Nonoi College, These are the following initiatives that Nonoi College is implementing in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020:

❖ **Programmes offered in line with NEP 2020(Arts)**

1. Bachelor's Degree in Arts with Major/Honors in Assamese
2. Bachelor's Degree in Arts with Major/Honors in English
3. Bachelor's Degree in Arts with Major/Honors in Education
4. Bachelor's Degree in Arts with Major/Honors in Political Science
5. Bachelor's Degree in Arts without Major/Honors (3 year degree programme).

❖ **Multiple Exit and Entry Points:**

Under the undergraduate program at Gauhati University, multiple exit and entry points are allowed at specific stages of the program. As per the NEP 2020, students have the option to exit the program and receive appropriate certifications after completing the 3rd, 5th, and 7th semesters. This provision offers flexibility to students who may choose to enter the workforce or pursue further studies after completing a certain number of semesters. By allowing multiple exit points, Gauhati University promotes inclusivity and recognizes diverse career trajectories for its students.

❖ **Certificate, Diploma and Degree:**

Gauhati University's four-year undergraduate program, following the guidelines of the NEP 2020, offers different certifications based on the stage of exit for students:

i. **Certificate:** If a student chooses to exit the program after completing one year, they will receive a Certificate. This certification acknowledges their successful completion of one year of undergraduate studies.

ii. **Diploma:** If a student decides to exit the program after completing two years, they will be awarded a Diploma.

This certification signifies their completion of two years of undergraduate studies and indicates a higher level of proficiency in their chosen field.

iii. **Degree with Major/Without Major:** If a student completes three years of the program and decides to exit, they will be conferred a Degree in a Stream with or without Major. This degree recognizes their completion of the full three-year undergraduate program and signifies their expertise in their chosen field of study.



iv. **Degree with Honours/Research:** For students who successfully complete the entire four-year undergraduate program, Gauhati University awards a Degree with Honors or Research. This degree recognizes their comprehensive education and signifies their excellence in their chosen discipline, as well as their potential for research or higher studies.

The multiple exit points and corresponding certifications provided by Gauhati University accommodate the diverse aspirations and career paths of students, allowing them to receive recognition for their academic accomplishments at different stages of their undergraduate journey.

v. **Progression:** Gauhati University's three-year degree program leads to admission in the MA 1st Year program. On the other hand, the four-year degree program allows students to directly enter the MA 2nd Year program or pursue a Ph.D., subject to certain conditions and eligibility criteria.

vi. **Major Change:** Students at Gauhati University have the opportunity to change their major during the 4th semester, provided they meet the specific requirements and conditions set by the university.

vii. **Course Structure and Credits:** The undergraduate program at Gauhati University, GU-FYUGP, consists of two main parts: Core Courses and Common Courses. In a three-year degree program (with or without a major), a minimum of 84 credits is allocated for Core Courses and 36 credits for Common Courses. In a four-year degree program, 120 credits are assigned for Core Courses, and 40 credits are allocated for Common Courses. The detailed list of Core and Common courses, along with the credits assigned to each, can be found in the provided Programmes Offered column.

Gauhati University's curriculum structure, credit allocation, and flexible options for major change and double majoring allow students to personalize their education and explore diverse academic pathways. These features promote interdisciplinary learning, academic progression, and the acquisition of a well-rounded skill set.

viii. **ABC:** Gauhati University is registered in the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC), which is a virtual academic mechanism facilitating the mobility of students within and between Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) across the country. As a result, all students of Nonoi College come under the purview of the ABC. At the end of each examination in GU-FYUGP, the university deposits all earned credits into the ABC for each student. To participate in this system, students must obtain an ABC ID through the Digi locker platform before admission.

ix. **Admission:** Prior to admission, students must first obtain an ABC ID. Once they have their ABC ID, they can proceed with the online admission process through the college's website (www.nonoicollege.in). Detailed information regarding the admission procedure can be found on the college's website, providing students with clear guidelines for successfully completing the admission process.

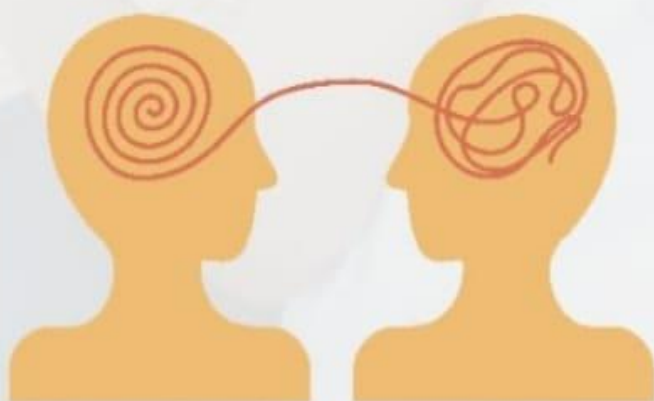
