BACKGROUND

Anger is a natural human reaction to frustration, stress or disappointment. We all become angry at times. It can occur in children as young as three or four months old. Anger can be quite noticeable in toddlers who often express it through tantrums and other aggressive actions. However, as they grow and develop, most children learn how to deal with some of the frustrations of everyday life. They also learn how to express their anger in acceptable ways. Some anger can be helpful. For example, when expressed effectively, anger can help tell someone else, "Stop. I don't like that." Anger can also motivate us to overcome problems and achieve goals. Whether children's anger is positive or negative depends on how effectively it is managed and whether it can be directed towards positive goals.

When children lack skills for managing anger it can lead to aggressive behavior. Usually, it is the aggressive action that follows anger that most concerns parents, careers and school staff. Learning to manage anger involves developing social and emotional skills for calming down and having ways to express angry feelings assertively. This means learning to use words rather than aggressive actions to communicate feelings. Parents, careers and school staff have an important role in helping children fearn to manage anger effectively.

Differences in children's use of anger

Before they start school, most young children have learned that getting aggressive when angry is not considered appropriate behaviour. They may have also learned some strategies for managing anger, for example, counting to 10, explaining what they are annoyed about, or asking an adult for help to resolve a problem. These are positive coping strategies that help children manage their angry feelings and build skills for effective relationships.

Some children try to manage angry feelings by avoiding the situation or person that has led them to be angry. Children who use this kind of strategy very often do not build effective skills for relating to others, which can cause them problems in later years. Some other children seem to have few strategies for managing anger and so may continue to act aggressively and impulsively. Children with anger problems are often rejected by other children because of their difficult behaviour. Feeling rejected, they may think others are being mean to them and become angrier. This may start a pattern of thinking that leads them to respond with aggressive behaviour even where no intention to hurt is present. For example, they may get angry when somebody bumps into them and react aggressively without stopping to think that it may have been an accident.

The different ways that children manage anger are influenced by a combination of personal characteristics, how much stress the child and family are under and opportunities available at home and school for learning how to cope with feelings. From early childhood, some children seem to react more to frustration and take longer to return to a calm state. These children may need extra assistance to learn skills for controlling anger. Some children don't learn how to manage anger because being angry is not okay in their families. They don't get the chance to practice

Principal, lic Nonoi College positive ways of managing anger or telling others when they are angry. Children can⁻⁻ also learn aggression through the examples of others. When the adults responsible for children's care get angry quickly and often, or when they use reactive, harsh andinconsistent discipline, children are more likely to behave aggressively themselves. Research indicates that physical aggression in children is most common at the age of two. As skills for language and thinking develop, aggressive behavior is reduced. However, for some primary school children aggression remains at a high level. These children may benefit from professional help to learn to control aggression and stop behavior problems becoming worse.

OBJECTIVES

- The main purpose of the programme such as this is to leach parents the safest and most effective ways to keep from having outbursts and rages.
- To create an awareness among parents of the many strategies available for resolving children's anger.
- Anger management participants are presented with anger scale to know the level of children's anger
- To handle problems in a way that is productive and think about solutions before they react.
- The goal is to help parents to teach their kids learn how to identify their anger triggers and anger cues, understand the consequences of their behavior, express and manage anger effectively and constructively, and how to respond to anger directed at them.

ABOUT THIS PROGRAMME:

In the session, parents were gain an understanding of anger and the functions it serves as well as knowledge of strategies to help their child self-manage strong emotion. From the test they became aware their child's anger tevel. The strategies of anger management introduced are embedded within positive parenting practices that support skill development in self-control. Parents were also taught in dealing with angry children, that their actions should be motivated by the need to protect and to reach, not by a desire to punish. There are various child's anger management strategies and parental tips presented in this session.

WHAT THIS PROGRAMME INCLUDES:

Conducting one test on anger, by Gary Oliver, for parents to know the anger level of their children. The inventory covers the more common signs of anger in children. All children manifest these signs, but if several of them are persistent or if their child evidences many of them, they may have a problem.

Criterion of rate each statement according to the scale:



0= My child never or rarely does this

1= My child occasionally does this (no more than once a month).

2= My child often (once or more a week) does this.

3= My child does this frequently (daily or several times a week).

In the inventory, 15 questions were asked to see the child's anger level.

Test Interpretation

0-5: Your child is remarkably free of anger and is not prone to frustration. If anything, he or she may be a little too passive- but don't try to change this!

6-10: Your child is showing a normal degree of anger and irritation, but a higher score (nearer 10) is more appropriate for younger children (under 6) and lower score (nearer 6) is more appropriate for older children.

11-15: Your child is beginning to show an above-normal degree of anger response. Again, a higher score is more appropriate for younger children. Some attention to your child's response may be needed.

16-20: Clearly your child has a problem with anger and should receive your attention. Over 20: Your child has a serious problem with anger, especially if he or she is already of school age. Take immediate sleps to help your child cope with his or her anger, and seek professional help, if necessary.

CONCLUSIONS

Upon completing the session parents are able to:

- Understand that anger is a normal human feeling.
- Recognize the difference between angry feelings and angry behaviors.
- Identify what triggers their anger.
- Become familiar with their child's physical anger warning signs.
- Identify children's characteristic ways of expressing anger.
- Know the anger level of their children's.
- Consider the consequences of angry behavior.
- Develop constructive and effective ways of expressing and handling their anger.
- Respond effectively to someone else's anger.

Whenever my child gets angry, calming him or her down takes a lot of placating.

4. My child does not like change of any sort and become angry when change is forced on him or her.

6. My child says spiteful or hatful things whenever he or she is thwarted.

7. My child is negative, deliberately slow and resists doing what he or she is told to do to the point that discipline becomes a standoff.

13. My child is stubborn and refuses to do what he or she is told to do unless you use the right tone of voice or approach.




REPORT


Program Report
