ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Admission to FYUGP 1st Semester class is open for those who have passed H.S. (10+2) standard examinations conducted by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council or Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) or any other equivalent examinations.

The application will have to be submitted along with attested photocopy of marksheet and certificates at the time of application. They will have to produce the original copies of the certificate and marksheet at the time of admission.

COLLEGE UNIFORM:

Boys: White Shirt and Black Trousers.

Girls: i) Muga or Muga Coloured Mekhela. Red blouse and Chadar with Red border or

ii) White Salwar Kameez and Red Surni.

iii) It is compulsory for the girls to wear mekhela-chadar on every Monday & Thursday.

N.B.: Every Student will have to wear Black Shoes. In winter Season they will have to wear black Sweater or coat.

- **Leggings are not allowed.**
- **Student without Uniform will not be allowed to attend classes.**

ATTENDANCE:

- i) To be eligible to appear in each semester final examination, a student must attend minimum classes in each individual subject as under- Minimum 75% and above: Eligible for the Examination.
- ii) Scholarship holders with less than 75% attendance may be deprived of the scholarship.

STUDENTS UNION:

Nonoi college student's union is the general body of students of the college and all the students are the member of the union. The election of Nonoi College student's union is held as per guide lines of Lyngdoh committee and The Honourable Supreme Court of India. Dated 22-09-2006. The guidelines are follows –

- 1) Under Graduate students between the ages of 17 and 22, Only can contest the election.
- 2) The candidates should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
- 3) The candidate should have the minimum percentage of attendance in classes as prescribed by the university of 75% attendance, whichever is higher.
- 4) The candidates shall not have previous criminal record. The candidates shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the college authority.
- 5) The candidate must be a regular full-time student of the college.

COLLEGE EXAMINATION:

There will be one sessional exam and one end semester exam in each semester, Sessional exam will be conducted by college and end semester exam will be conducted by G.U. FYUGP Semester System: 20% of total marks comes from internal assessment/evaluation and rest from end Semester evaluation. There Shall be at least one Sessional examination in each Semester. Pass Mark is 40%, If anybody fails in internal assessment then he will be declared fail even he/she scores pass mark in the last semester evaluation.

GENERAL RULES FOR MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE AND ACADEMIC ATMOSPHERE AMONG STUDENTS

- The students will have to abide by college rules and regulations.
- Violation of College rules and regulation may lead to suspension or expulsion from the college.
- Possession and consumption of any intoxicating substance inside the College campus is strictly prohibited.
- All powers of maintenance of discipline and good academic atmosphere are vested in the principal and his decision shall be final in such matters.

- A student is not allowed to enter the college campus, class room & examination hall with Mobile Phone.
- Students are not allowed to meet friends in the college campus during college hours.
- Students without Uniform will not allow to attend classes and in examination hall.
- The course of absence must be informed to obtain permission from the principal to attend classes after remaining absent for more than 3 days at stretch.

It also enables youth, especially the female students to identify and understand situations of exploitation and abuse. It tries to sensitise the youth and instill in them the spirit of helping and supporting people living with HIV/AIDS and reduce the stigma and discrimination against them. The RRC increases youths' access to health care services related to STI/HIV/AIDS/drug use.

The key areas of RRC are to motivate youth and build their capacity as peer educators by developing their skills on leadership, negotiation and team building. It also aims to promote voluntary non-remunerated blood donation among youth.

Deenanath Bora Library: Where Knowledge Meets Inspiration

The Deenanath Bora Library, the central library of the college, has been an integral part of the institution since its establishment in 1985. Serving as a cornerstone of academic excellence, the library is thoughtfully designed with a reading room and a well-equipped reference section, creating a conducive environment for study and research.

The library primarily operates through student contributions, which form the main source of its budget for acquiring books, periodicals, and other essential learning resources and equipment. Despite its modest size, it offers a rich and diverse collection that supports the academic needs of students and faculty alike.

In terms of borrowing facilities, students enrolled in B.A. (Minor/General) courses are allowed to borrow up to two books for a period of 15 days, while B.A. Major students may borrow three books at a time. All students are required to return borrowed books before the declaration of results of sessional tests or annual examinations; failure to do so may result in the withholding of their results. For students' convenience, safe drinking water (Aqua guard) is available near the library, and separate toilet facilities for boys and girls are provided within the campus, ensuring a comfortable and student-friendly environment.

The library offers a comprehensive range of services and resources to support teaching, learning, and research, including a collection of approximately 4623 books, open access facilities, and free internet browsing.

These include an Open Access system, free internet browsing, and access to digital platforms such as NLIST, DELNET, and NDLI. Additional facilities include a Book Bank, External Membership, Current Awareness Service, Reference Service, and a variety of E-resources. The library is also equipped with OPAC and Web OPAC systems, an Institutional Repository, Manuscript Archive, North East Collection, a dedicated Collection on Women, a Children's Corner, a Digital Question Bank, and a Rare Books Collection.

These comprehensive resources and services make the Deenanath Bora Library a vibrant hub of knowledge, committed to fostering intellectual growth and supporting the academic journey of both students and teachers.

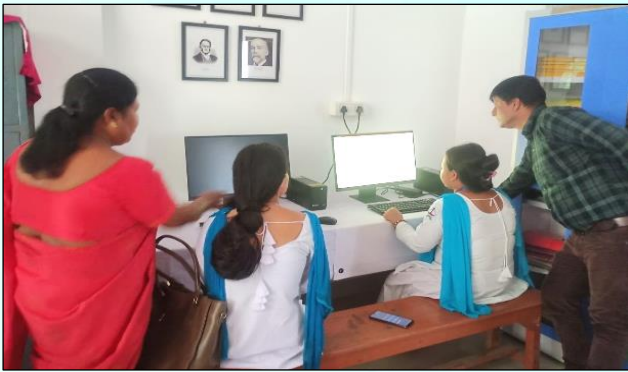
