A Proud Participation of Nonoi College in "Khelo India Samvaad – Khel Ki Baat PM Modi Ke Saath"

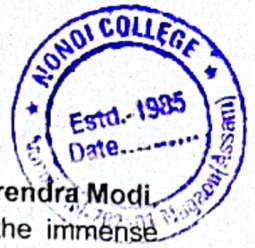
Nonoi College, Nonoi, Nagaon | 27 August 2026

NAGAON, Aug 27: The 'Khelo India Sangbad' programme under the Viksit Bharat Youth Connect initiative of My Bharat, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, was successfully organised at Nonoi College in Nagaon on Thursday, with more than 500 students participating. The event was jointly organised by My Bharat Kendra, Nagaon, and the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Nonoi College. Dr Mukutmoni Saikia, Principal of Nonoi College, delivered the welcome address, while Dr Basanta Bora, Programme Officer, NSS, and Dr Sukanya Bora, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychology, anchored the programme.

Dhananjay Takurkar, Accounts and Programme Officer, My Bharat Centre, Nagaon, explained the objectives of the initiative and highlighted its key aspects.

The programme concluded with the National Anthem. As part of the same initiative, 'Khelo India Sangbad' programmes were also organised at Kaliahar College, Lanka College and Lunding College in Hojai district.

More than 300 youth, athletes and sports organisers participated at each venue.
