Election Notice – II

Eligibility criteria of Candidates:

- A) All the regular students have the right to take part in the process of the Nonoi College Student Union (NCSU) election.
- B) Students between the age of 17 to 22 years, may contest in NCSU election.
- C) Students' who have no academic arrears, shall be eligible to contest in the NCSU election.
- D) Students whose average class attendance is less than 75%, shall not be eligible to contest in the NCSU election.
- E) A candidate shall get one opportunity to contest for a Post of office Bearer.
- F) The Candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say, he/she should not have been tried and/or convicted of any criminal offence. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the college authority.
- G) A contesting candidate can propose or support another candidate.
- H) A candidate can voluntarily withdraw his/her candidature. The opinion of his/her proposer or supporter shall have no say over the candidate's decision.

Strictly Prohibited

- 1. No postering and writing inside the college campus.
- 2. No Banner inside the college campus.
- 3. Criticism of other candidates is strictly prohibited.
- There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes.
 Places of worship, within or without the campus shall not be used for election Propaganda.
- 5. All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting all activities which are considered to be "corrupt practices" and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, canvassing or the used of propaganda within 100 meters of polling stations, holding public meetings during the period of 24 hours ending with the hour fixed for the closed of the poll, and transport and conveyance of voters to and from polling stations.
- The use of loudspeakers, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.

On the day of poll

- Every student will have to show their Identity card during the time of entering into the polling station.
- 2) Polling will be held from 9 AM to 1 PM. on 29/10/2025
- In polling and counting centre, every candidate will be allowed to appoint one agent.
- 4) Every agent will have to submit their appointment letters to the Presiding Officer within 08:30 AM. If case of agents are found absent in the polling station within the stipulated time, there will be no change in starting the poll. Polling will be started at 9:00 AM without fail.
- 5) No candidate will be allowed to campaign on the day of poll.
- 6) No student will be allowed to cast their votes if they come without college uniform.
- 7) The nomination fees is non-refundable.
- 8) It is compulsory for each proposer and supporter to submit the latest fee receipt along with the certificate showing 75% attendance in the class in each subjects.
- 9) The decision of the election committee will be considered as final.
- 10) The counting of votes will be held on the same day (i.e 29/10/2025) and the results will also be declared on the same day after the counting of votes.

No candidates will be allowed to arrange rally for their election victory.
